May Focus: Timothy

Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.

1 Timothy 4:12

Of all of the people from the Bible that we have studied so far this year, we may know the least about Timothy. What we do know is that he had a very close relationship with Paul (as seen in 1 Tim. 2) that he was young, especially considering he was leading a church in Ephesus at the time, and that he was striving to work against false teachings that were being preached within the church. So even though we don't know a lot about the life of young Timothy, we do know that he was indeed a peculiar person. He was confronting those who were teaching wrong doctrine and leading people astray. Paul encouraged him, as can be seen by this month's Bible memory verse, an example to everyone within the church, whether young or old. What a great example Timothy is for our TCS kids. He shows that no matter how young you might be you can and should stand up for what is right and, if need be, be willing to be standing alone. How peculiar!
