



Mercy & Faithfulness

Do you ever wake up and wonder, "How am I going to get through today?"

It feels as though you will never make it with so much going on.

The good news is that God has given us exactly what we need for today.

Lamentations 3:22-23 says;

The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases;

his mercies never come to an end;

they are new every morning;

I want to remind you of two truths:

1) God's love NEVER ceases. Stop. Think about what you just read. Remind your heart at this moment, "I. AM. LOVED."

2) God's mercies never come to an end. This also is not a flaky, feel-good type of statement. This is the promise and reality of the gospel. Jesus' mercy NEVER comes to an end. **You cannot outrun or run out of the mercy Jesus has for you.**

3)"His mercies are new every morning." This means is, every day you wake up and God has gone before you. He already knows what you need for this day.

Stop.

Read that again.

He has given you all you need for today. So don't stress about tomorrow yet, don't allow fear to creep in and rob you of the joy of today.

Watch, listen and give thanks for the mercy God will pour out in your life today. Live in reality, that in His grace, He died in your place. In His power, He rose again, and for His glory, He will return.

REFLECTION

Spend a moment and write down a few ways you have seen God's faithfulness in your life. Then, express to Him your gratitude for His mercy and ask Him to show you how you can share this love and grace with others.
