- K-4 PE: rhythmic gymnastics/gymnastics. We had an amazing time skating!
- K: Easter, with Resurrection Eggs, Benjamin's Box and treasure hunt. Jelly
- bean math, fairy tales, "popcorn words", Treehouse field trip, writing sentences
- Gr 1: In-class field trip about communities. Narnia Day!

- Gr 2: In-class field trip on French-Acadian culture; they got to make butter and see how wool is turned in to tapestries!
- Gr 3: Financial literacy: looking at the cost of toys for recess, did some investigating and voted. Data points are being used to make purchases
- Gr 4: Marble Run projects happening in science
- Gr 5: History and Stories of Canada, made fruit salad to look at mixing in chemistry
- Gr 6: Celebrating their study of Ancient Athens with Mrs. Theissen dressing the part!
