## **GRADE 9 LEGACY PROJECT**

One of the grade nine curriculum learning outcomes involves learning to write formal business emails. To reach this outcome, we have implemented a grade 9 Legacy Project that combines this learning outcome with a tangible purpose. Therefore, our grade 9 students have written emails to over 132 business in Calgary. Why? - They have requested items and gift cards from these businesses in our communities to sell in an online auction starting March 18. We hope our combined auctions items will sell for over \$7500 in support of Communities for Life - a local, non-profit organization developing sustainable work efforts in the poverty stricken community of Manchay, Peru.
